

FOR YOUR SAFETY

Please read and understand all safety rules before assembling and using this pellet fire pit, failure to follow these instructions could result in a hazardous fire, causing property damage and/or physical injury.

RULES FOR SAFE OPERATION

Caution: For outdoor use only. Do not use indoors.

- For adult use only- Do not allow children to use this fire pit.
- Keep children and pets away from the fire pit while in use.
- Do not use under a patio roof, low hanging branches, trellis's or overhangs of any kind including covered porches.
- Do not use when windy.
- Do not leave a lit fire unattended.
- This fire pit is designed for use with wood pellets only.
- Do not burn charcoal briquettes, lump charcoal, manufactured logs, driftwood, trash, leaves, paper, cardboard, plywood, anything painted or stained, or pressure treated wood.
- Do not use flammable liquids such as gasoline, alcohol, diesel fuel, kerosene, to light or relight fires.
- Do not use fire pit near any combustible materials.
- Always adhere to applicable local and/or state fire codes.
- Use the same precautions as you would with any open flame.
- Use extreme caution with long hair and/or wearing loose clothing when tending the fire.
- All surfaces of this fire pit are hot while in use. To avoid burns and/or injury, do NOT touch the fire pit until the fire is completely extinguished and has cooled down. Use a thermometer to test the surface heat before moving if you are not sure.
- Be positive the fire and ashes are completely extinguished before leaving the fire pit or moving into a structure or vehicle.
- Clean and inspect your fire pit after each use.
- Do not modify this fire pit. Any modifications may cause damage to the fire pit or the user.
- Do not move the fire pit while it's in operation.
- Do not place fire pit a walking area or anywhere it may cause a trip hazard.

ASSEMBLY AND LIGHTING:

NO TOOLS REQUIRED

1. Choose a level location to place your fire pit. Remove all combustible materials away from the area where you are going to place your fire pit, including leaves, branches, dead grass, etc. Look above the fire pit to assure no overhead combustibles. **DO NOT USE ON WOOD OR COMPOSITE DECKS!**
2. Remove the base ring (smaller ring) from inside the larger ring.
3. Place base ring (smaller ring) on your prepared level surface from Step 1.
4. Locate the mounting tabs on the bottom of the burn ring (larger ring).



5. Line up tabs with the slots on the base ring. Your fire pit is now assembled and ready for use.
6. Add wood pellets into the burn chamber until they reach the fill lines on the interior of the burn ring. No need to fill above the lines. Average fire with hardwood pellets to the fill lines will last 30-40 minutes before needing more pellets. Heating type wood pellets are typically much cheaper than cooking type pellets, but either will work well. **HINT-** Keep your wood pellets as dry as possible before use, using wet or damp pellets will affect the burn quality of the fire pit.
7. Use a fire starting block, cube, pod, or gel for safe and fast lighting. Place your preferred starter method in the center of the wood pellets, light the fire starter, and then sit back and relax. The fire starter should ignite the wood pellets quickly. It may take a couple minutes for the burn to reach the full diameter of the burn ring.

TENDING THE FIRE:

After the wood pellets have started to diminish to ash you will need to add more wood pellets if you wish to keep the fire going (like adding a log to a campfire). Use a small metal scoop to slowly sprinkle more wood pellets to fire. Usually every 15 -25 minutes. Do NOT dump pellets rapidly into the fire, this may cause excessive smoke or extinguish the fire. Instead, slowly sprinkle 1-2 cups of wood pellets on at a time. NEVER use lighter fluid or other combustible liquids to relight the fire if you accidentally extinguished it when adding wood pellets, Injury or Death may occur.

When you are finished with your fire, do not add any more wood pellets and the fire will automatically burn out. Stop adding the wood pellets approximately 30 minutes before you want to finish your fire.

Once the fire pit is completely extinguished and cooled, remove any ashes from the base and the burn ring. Place the base ring back into the burn ring and your fire pit is ready for storage.
